Ephesians 6:1-4 – "*Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. 'Honor your father and mother,' which is the first commandment with promise: 'that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.'* And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord."

Note the Apostle's Evangelical Admonitions:

Paul uses a series of present tense imperatives indicating an ongoing exercise on the part of the believing child of God!

- Keep on obeying! Literally: under + listen = to submit, to obey.

Colossians 3:20 - "*Children, obey your parents in all things, for this is well pleasing to the Lord.*"

- Keep on honoring! The underlying idea is to place a high value on something or someone, in this case one's parents.

John 6:23 – "*All should honor the Son just as they honor the Father.*"

- "Stop provoking your children! Literally: to arouse to anger.

- Keep on bringing up! The underlying idea is to feed or provide nourishment.

Deuteronomy 6:7 – "*You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.*"
